

PUBS • MEMBERS' CLUBS • SPORTS AND SOCIAL CLUBS • FUNCTION VENUES

You already have cameras and an alarm panel in every venue. Open both from **head office**.

Today the recorder sits in the cellar off the network and the panel dials out over a phone line. A TetherBox on the same broadband adopts both, and your area manager opens any venue in a browser.

Cameras, doors, the intruder panel and the cellar sensors then raise their events on one timeline, whatever brand somebody fitted ten years ago.



ONE TRADING DAY

Four shifts, four different questions.

Burglaries are rare. Your auditor asks about a refund nobody can explain, a cellar door opened on a shift nobody worked, and who was still in at three.

17:00 Trading The bar, the floor and the tills are all in shot, and every camera records on the box whether the internet holds or not.	23:00 Last orders A refusal, a walk-out or a scuffle at the door, recorded with the door events beside it and kept for the claim.	00:30 Lock-up Your manager checks the rooms on a phone, sets the alarm, and the cellar sensors carry on reporting overnight.	02:40 After hours The camera behind the bar raises an event when something moves. You talk down a break-in. You send a lock-in to the area manager.

ONE VENUE OR THE WHOLE ESTATE

Tenanted, managed and members' clubs on **one account**.

Area managers and tenants An area manager sees their venues, a tenant sees only their own, and the committee of a club sees the club. An administrator sets that once.	Take a venue on in an afternoon Your installer fits the box, scans the network and adopts the cameras that are already up. About fifteen minutes once it is on the network.	Watched after hours by an operator Nobody is on site overnight, so a verified alarm goes to a monitoring station with the clip attached. Take ours, or keep the one you already pay (Immix, Patriot and others).	Back up only what you need Record on the box, and copy to the cloud only the cameras that carry evidence. You pick those camera by camera.
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You run the whole chain from one map. Each pin carries the state of that TetherBox and its cameras, so your area manager finds the offline venue and the failed camera without opening a single one.

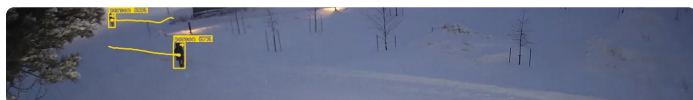

WHEN SOMEBODY ASKS FOR THE FOOTAGE

Send the clip that morning,
without opening the cellar.

An officer, a solicitor or an insurer asks for the incident. Your manager opens that evening's recording, filters to people instead of motion, and exports the two minutes that matter rather than handing over everyone else.

- Search by time, by camera and by what the AI classified.
- Share a link that expires on a date you set, and revoke it early if you need to.
- Each export records the person who took it, the camera and the minute.



WHAT A LICENSEE ASKS IN THE FIRST MEETING

You check the cellar and the closing-up from your phone.

**Sensors in the cellar**

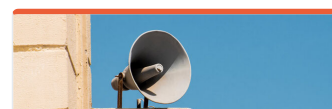
A probe on the fridges, a CO2 detector on the gas, a flow meter on the line, a contact on the hatch. Each reads over Modbus, a relay or an IoT feed.

**The 00:30 to 05:00 question**

Set the window and the cameras you care about, and read what moved behind the bar overnight across the whole estate, without opening a single timeline.

**The alarm, beside the cameras**

Your intruder panel reports set, unset and in alarm on the same timeline, so you spot a zone that never set before you drive home.

**Speak to the beer garden**

Talk down from a phone where a speaker is fitted, so a gathering at closing time ends without a member of staff going out to it.

THREE THINGS A LICENSEE ASKS THAT ARE NOT ABOUT CAMERAS

Nobody watches a monitor.

One person locks up, so the cameras and sensors raise the question and ring whoever is on call.

We train your team free.

Where you have your own security or facilities staff, we train them to run the platform.

Your footage stays in your own region.

You pick where each venue records, and we log every view and download.

WHAT THE SHEET IS WORTH ON A MONDAY

Three questions you stop guessing at.

**Follow one refund end to end**

Open the till camera and the bar camera together, and follow one refund start to finish.

**The 02:00 callout, avoided**

Your manager clears most out-of-hours alarms from a phone, so nobody drives back for a moth on a lens.

**It happened, or it did not**

A slip, a refusal or a complaint about the function room is settled with a time-stamped clip.
